WHAT IS INVOLVED?

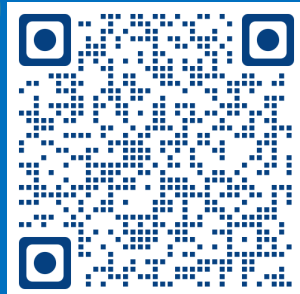
- You and a research partner will come to Cambridge for a **medical exam, puzzles, questionnaires, brain scans and a blood test.**
